Holly reported on the following work performed, including:

Mowing & lawn maintenance-scheduled to begin this week, weather permitting

Clubhouse- stairs from upper level to mid-level of the parking lot were power washed; windows were cleaned inside & out; AED delivered 5/3/22

Lighthouse-the lighthouse & the stone base along with the gunite foundation were pressure washed; Board will be looking at design for landscape & irrigation for the area behind the lighthouse

Skyline Park-removed weeds from walking trail path; checked exercise equipment to insure proper operation

Fishing Lake-Silt that had accumulated on the boat ramp has been removed; road from gate to ramp has been repaired; Associated to check well #7 at the boat ramp this week-currently non-operational; Board has approved Twin Oaks lake management co. to apply fertilizer, create add'l. aquatic vegetation, accumulate data from fisherman re: length, weight, type of fish caught to further recommend actions to improve health of the lake; Twin Oaks will

recommend types of fish feeders & fish food to use to improve the quality of the fish-Board will possibly be adding 1-2 feeders

Beacon Lake-the Board has approved application of herbicide to remove pondweed by Twin Oaks lake management co., date to be determined

Beacon Lake park-the playground equipment has been cleaned & minor repairs completed; broken branches have been cleaned up & hauled off; backfilled voids behind retaining wall @ lake

Pool-Opened April 1; New drinking fountain has been installed; New emergency phone & signage have been installed. Underside of roof structure over the bathrooms, cabana, & seating area has been pressure washed; main disconnect to the pool/cabana area was tripped by a skunk - 100-amp breaker to pool pump room sub panel was burned up & replaced, 200 amp main disconnect has been replaced; area around the transformer & main disconnect has been cleared out for easier access; septic system pump replaced 4/27/22; cleaned up areas where hogs dug up the grass near pool entrance & in Beacon Lake park; AED delivered 5/3/22
